DESCRIPTION

Table lamp with diffused light. Hand-blown glass diffuser with glossy finish, using a "stationary" glass-blowing technique without turning the glass in the mould. Die cast aluminium base, hand finished and polished. For the large version, upper diffuser screen in opaline glare-proof PMMA, ON/OFF switch on the black cable. For the small version, dimmer fitted on the black cable to adjust the brightness gradually.

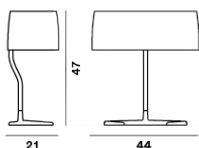
technical details

FOSCARINI

Esa is a table lamp with a timeless elegance. The glossy blown glass diffuser with an ellipsoidal base is white on the inside to reflect light. Available in two sizes to adapt to a variety of uses, the diffuser of the small version closes completely at the top, becoming a single whole. The diffuser of the large version is instead fitted with an opaline screen to avoid glare. The glossy aluminium support recalls the soft shape of the diffuser: the rod is curved and is secured to an ellipsoidal base that does not close completely.

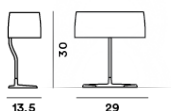
